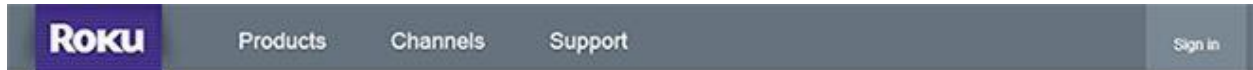


Adding International Flix onto your Roku



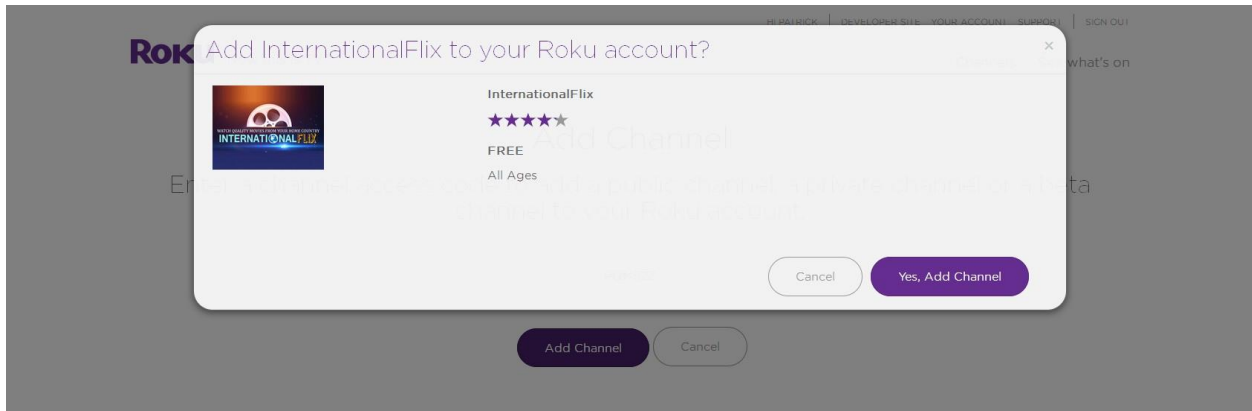
